8:00 - 9:00 am	Take handover from night SHO, identify new admissions from overnight. Prep new patients on Bickleigh /Torcross. Print CPL list for the board round.	Take handover from night SHO, identify any admissions to Bickleigh + post elective admissions. Prep notes + put out bloods as required and write them in DA's book. Complete TTA's for elective patients. Print CPL list for the board round.	Take handover from night SHO, identify new admissions to Braunton. Prep notes + put out bloods as required and write them in DA's book. Complete TTA's for elective patients. Print CPL list for the board round.
9:00 – 9:30 am	Board round with ACS registrar + ACS consultant (Bickleigh)	Board round with the nurse in charge + ACS consultant (this is your chance to highlight any medical issues/concerns so this can be addressed by the consultant appropriately.)	Board round with the Consultant, nurse in charge and SpR Ali (this is your chance to highlight any medical issues/concerns so this can be addressed by the consultant appropriately.)
09:30 – (variable)	Ward round with ACS consultant (will see everyone on Torcross and new admissions on Bickleigh)	SHO led ward round with senior support (ward registrar.) Consultants will see new patients on Bickleigh.	Ward round with Braunton consultant + SHO led ward round with SPR Ali's support. Usually, on Monday, all patients will be seen but will vary during the rest of the week and most consultants will only see new admissions/trouble shoot.
Afternoon	Jobs (requesting scans/x-rays/bloods etc + TTAs.) Be aware that you may be asked to do bloods/cannulations as there is no designated DA for Torcross. You will be expected to look after the ACS list.	Jobs (requesting scans/x-rays/bloods etc + TTAs.) There will be a DA cover.	Jobs (requesting scans/x-rays/bloods etc + TTAs.) 16:00 – 20:00	On call SHO will cover all the cardiology wards and be expected to clerk any new admission and do jobs, review any sick/deteriorating patients, and escalate as necessary. There will be the day ACS registrar who will also be on call till 20:00.
20:00 – 20:30	Handover to night SHO in Bickleigh
20:30 – 8:00am	You will also be covering cardiothoracics at night (there should be a cardiothoracics ANP on overnight with you.) Attend cardiothoracics handover (Clearbrook) and collect the night bleep. Also collect the hand bleep from ACT office, level 6. You will be expected to clerk any new admissions overnight and do jobs, review any sick/deteriorating patients, and escalate as necessary. There will be a cardiology registrar on site, all night for support for cardiology patients. Questions though regarding cardiothoracic patients should be escalated to the on-call cardiothoracic SpR on overnight. No DA cover overnight so you will be expected to do bloods if required.
